Through Chase Travel, customers can book flights, hotels, rental cars, cruises, and vacation packages.

Chase Travel partners with Expedia Group to power its booking engine, but cancellation rules depend on the airline, hotel or rental car provider, fare or room type, timing of cancellation, and whether you used points, cash, or a combination.

✈️ □ Chase Travel Cancellation Policy Overview

Chase Travel does not set its own cancellation rules — instead, it follows the policies of the travel provider such as the airline, hotel, or rental agency ✈️ +1 888 = 483 = 9719.

Always review your fare type and provider policy before requesting a Chase Travel cancellation.

✈️ □ **How to Cancel a Chase Travel Booking**

Chase Travel offers multiple ways to cancel your booking — the fastest method is usually through your Chase account.

1 □ □ **Cancel Online Through Your Chase Account** ✈️ +1 888 = 483 = 9719

You can cancel most Chase Travel bookings directly online in a few simple steps:

- **Step 1:** Log in to your Chase account.
- **Step 2:** Navigate to Chase Travel from your account dashboard.
- **Step 3:** Select "My Trips" or "Manage Bookings."

- **Step 5:** Review the cancellation policy carefully before proceeding.

2 □ □ **Cancel by Calling Chase Travel Support**

If your booking is complex, involves multiple passengers, or is within 24 hours of departure, calling Chase Travel Support is often the best option.

How to find the Chase Travel Support Number:

- **Log in to your Chase account:** The support number is usually listed in the "Help" or "Contact Us" section of the travel portal.
- **Check the back of your Chase credit card:** The general customer service line can direct your call.
- **Review your booking confirmation email:** It often contains contact information for support.

3 □ □ **Cancel Through the Airline or Hotel (Sometimes Allowed)**

- **Airlines:** Some airlines allow you to manage your reservation directly on their website after booking through Chase Travel. However, not all airlines allow third-party cancellations.
- **Hotels:** Hotels booked under non-refundable rates cannot be canceled directly.
- **Rental Cars:** Rental car agencies may also require cancellation through Chase Travel.

When in doubt, **check your confirmation email** — it will specify where cancellations must be made.

✈️ **Chase Travel Flight Cancellation Policy**

Flight cancellations are the most complex because rules vary by airline and fare type.

24-Hour Free Cancellation (U.S. DOT Rule)

For flights departing from or arriving in the U.S., you may qualify for free cancellation within 24 hours of booking, as long as:

- The flight is booked at least 7 days before departure.
- The airline participates in the DOT rule.
- The fare is eligible.

Chase Travel typically honors this rule, but some basic economy fares may be excluded.

Basic Economy Tickets

Most airlines do not allow cancellations or changes on basic economy fares unless:

- The airline offers a 24-hour grace period.
- The airline has a special waiver.
- You purchased a flexible basic economy fare.

Refundable Tickets

Refundable tickets can be canceled anytime and receive a full refund to the original payment method.

Non-Refundable Tickets

Non-refundable tickets usually receive travel credit, not cash. Airline rules apply and change fees may apply depending on the carrier.

Airline-Issued Travel Credits

If you cancel a non-refundable ticket, credits are issued by the airline and must be used before expiration. **Chase Travel cannot override airline rules.**

❑ Chase Travel Hotel Cancellation Policy

Hotel cancellation rules depend entirely on the hotel and room type.

Free Cancellation Rooms

Many hotels offer free cancellation until a specific date and time — typically 24–72 hours before check-in. A refund is issued to the original payment method and points are refunded instantly.

Non-Refundable Rooms

These are often labeled as "Non-refundable," "Pay now, no refunds," or "Advance purchase rate." These **cannot be canceled for a refund**, even if you call Chase Travel Support.

No-Show Policy

If you fail to check in, the hotel may charge the full stay, no refund is issued, and points may not be returned.

❑ Chase Travel Rental Car Cancellation Policy

Rental car cancellations are generally flexible through Chase Travel.

- Most Chase Travel rental car bookings allow free cancellation up to pick-up time with a refund to the original payment method.
- Prepaid rentals may charge a cancellation fee.
- Third-party rental agencies may have stricter rules.

❑ Chase Travel Cruise Cancellation Policy

Cruises have the strictest cancellation rules through Chase Travel.

Refunds When You Paid With Cash

Refunds typically return to your original payment method within:

- **3–7 business days** for hotels and cars
- **7–14 business days** for flights
- **Up to 30 days** for cruises or packages

Refunds When You Paid With Points

- Points are usually refunded instantly.
 - If the airline issues a credit instead of a refund, points may not be returned to your account.
 - Mixed cash + points refunds are split accordingly.
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❑ **Does Chase Travel Offer Trip Insurance?**

Some Chase cards include built-in travel protections such as:

- Trip cancellation/interruption insurance

- Trip delay reimbursement
- Lost luggage reimbursement
- Travel accident insurance

Coverage depends on your card. Always review your card's benefits guide for full details.

□ **When You Should Call Chase Travel Support**

You should contact Chase Travel Support when:

- Your flight is within 24 hours and you need an urgent cancellation or change.
- You need to change a multi-city itinerary or a complex vacation package.
- You booked with both points and cash and need to adjust your reservation.
- Your airline directs you back to Chase to handle a modification or refund.
- You received an error when canceling online.
- You need help with a cruise cancellation.

To find the correct support number:

- Log in to your Chase account and visit the Travel portal's "Help" section.
 - Call the number on the back of your Chase credit card and ask to be transferred to the Travel department.
