

The Ultimate Guide [2026] How to Modify Flight on Chase Travel Portal?

Making changes to your travel itinerary doesn't have to be a source of stress. Whether your plans have shifted or you need to react to an airline schedule change, understanding **how to modify flight on Chase Travel portal** is the key to protecting your investment and your time.

Step-by-Step: How to Modify Flight on Chase Travel Portal Online

For most standard economy and business class tickets, you can initiate a change through the self-service dashboard. Here is the exact workflow:

1. Access Your Ultimate Rewards Dashboard

Log in to your account at Chase.com or via the Chase Mobile app. Navigate to the **"Benefits & Rewards"** section and select your travel-eligible card (such as the Sapphire Reserve or Preferred). Click on **"Travel"** to enter the portal.

2. Locate Your Itinerary

Once inside the portal, click on **"My Trips"** or the profile icon. You will see a list of your upcoming reservations. Select the specific flight you wish to change.

3. Select "Modify Flight"

4. Review Fare Differences and Fees

When You CANNOT Modify Online (And What to Do)

Sometimes, the "Modify" button is missing or greyed out. This typically happens in the following scenarios:

- **Basic Economy Tickets:** Most Basic Economy fares are "use it or lose it." To see if an exception can be made, you must call +1 ⇒ (888) → 483 → 97.19 📞 .
- **Mixed Bookings:** If you booked a "Hacker Fare" (two one-way tickets on different airlines), the portal cannot sync them.

- **Partially Used Tickets:** If you have already flown the outbound leg and only need to change the return.
- **Airline Schedule Changes:** If the airline changed your flight by more than 2 hours, you are often entitled to a full refund or a free change, but the portal's automated system may not recognize this "protected" status.

Understanding Airline Credits vs. Points Refunds

Paid with Cash/Card	Standard airline credit rules apply.

Pro Tip: If the airline cancels your flight, you are legally entitled to a refund to your original form of payment (points back to your account and cash back to your card). Do not let an automated system force you into a travel credit if the flight was cancelled by the carrier!
