Why Knowing How to Contact Chase Travel for Flight Cancellation Matters

9. Log in to chase.com and navigate to the Chase Travel portal.
10. Click 'Trips' or 'My Bookings' in the main navigation.
11. Select the flight booking you need to cancel.
12. Click 'Cancel Flight' — note this button only appears for eligible refundable or flexible fares.
13. Review the refund or credit terms displayed on screen before confirming.
14. Submit the cancellation and note the confirmation number provided.
15. Check your email within 30 minutes for a formal cancellation confirmation.

If the portal shows you are not eligible for a self-service cancellation, or if the cancellation terms are unclear, stop and call +1-(888)-483-9719 immediately. Attempting to force a cancellation through the portal on a restricted fare may forfeit your refund rights entirely.

Method 3: Chase Mobile App — Cancel or Contact on the Go

- Baggage Delay Insurance — Covers essential purchases if your checked bags are delayed or lost following a cancelled flight.
- Travel Accident Insurance — Provides coverage for accidental death or dismemberment during common carrier travel.

To activate any of these protections, call +1-(888)-483-9719 and tell the agent your flight was cancelled and you need to file a benefit claim. They will initiate the process, explain the documentation required, and provide a claim reference number.

What to Do If Your Flight Is Cancelled While You Are Abroad
