What Is Levitra?

Levitra is a brand name for *Vardenafil*, a PDE-5 inhibitor used for treating Erectile Dysfunction (ED). It is *ten times more biochemically potent than Sildenafil*, and it has a lower risk of side effects.

This medication is U.S. Food And Drug Administration-approved to treat Erectile Dysfunction in males with difficulty having or keeping an erection.

It is not recommended for people with kidney or liver problems, and the dose should be taken *25 to 60 minutes* before indulging in sexual activity.

Levitra is a round shaped orange tablet with *LAYER* imprinted on the one side with the medicine's strength on the other.

Levitra is available in 5mg, 10mg, and 20mg strength at 'Chemist Trust' with up to 25% instant discount.

Why Levitra Is Used

Erectile Dysfunction (ED)

- Levitra is a 10 times more potent medication than Viagra, and it is a prescription medication recommended to treat *erectile dysfunction (ED)*.
- It is used to increase blood flow and helps in keeping and maintaining an erection in people with an inability to achieve and sustain an erection.

Its benefits are the same as those of Sildenafil or Viagra, but the effects of Viagra last between 2 – 4 *hours*, whereas the impacts of Levitra last for up to 5 *hours* after taking the dose.

How Does It Work

It works by enlarging blood vessels in the penis, allowing for more blood to flow without affecting the other body parts helping in maintaining an erection.

It prevents PDE-5 from working and promotes more blood flow that cannot be stopped by PDE-5.

Levitra works faster and more effectively if you take the dose on an empty stomach. But, if it is taken with food or a high-fat meal, then it will take longer to work.

Vardenafil should be taken 25 – 60 *minutes before having sex*, as it starts working within 30 *minutes of use*, and its effectiveness *lasts for up to 5 hours* after taking the dose.

What Should I Tell My Healthcare Provider Before Using Levitra?

Most adults can use Levitra on a doctor's prescription, but people with certain health conditions are not recommended to use this medication.

Tell your doctor before using Levitra if you have –

- Kidney or liver disease
- Risk of painful erection
- History of stomach bleeding
- Blood disease, leukemia, or sickle cell anemia
- Suffering from rare inherited eye disease or vision problems
- Peyronie's disease or history of priapism or bleeding disorders
- Unusual allergic reaction to vardenafil, other medications, dyes, or preservatives
