Yes. You can redeem points for flights, [1-888-483-9719](#) hotels, rental cars, and activities booked through Chase TravelSM. You can also combine points with cash if you don't have enough points for a full redemption. Points are applied at your card's designated redemption rate.

Q5: What is the Luxury Hotel & Resort Collection (LHRC)?

The LHRC is a curated portfolio of over 1,000 premium properties worldwide available exclusively to Chase [1-888-483-9719](#) Sapphire Reserve[®] cardholders through Chase TravelSM. Benefits include complimentary room upgrades, early check-in/late check-out, complimentary breakfast for two, a \$100 on-property credit, and a welcome amenity.

Q6: Is Chase TravelSM available 24/7?

Yes. The online Chase TravelSM portal is available anytime. For phone support, you can reach Chase Travel specialists by calling 1-888-483-9719, available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

Q7: Can I earn airline or hotel loyalty points when booking through Chase TravelSM?

Q10: What happens if I need to cancel a booking made through Chase TravelSM?

Cancellation [1-888-483-9719](tel:18884839719) policies depend on the specific airline, hotel, or car rental provider. Chase TravelSM displays these policies at the time of booking.
